Energy Savings Opportunity Scheme (ESOS)

The 14th of December 2014 marks the qualification date for the Government’s new mandatory Energy Savings Opportunity Scheme (ESOS). The scheme will introduce compulsory energy audits for all large enterprises, to encourage the uptake of cost effective energy efficiency measures.

All organisations must have complied with the legislation by 5th December 2015 if they are defined as a large enterprise.
